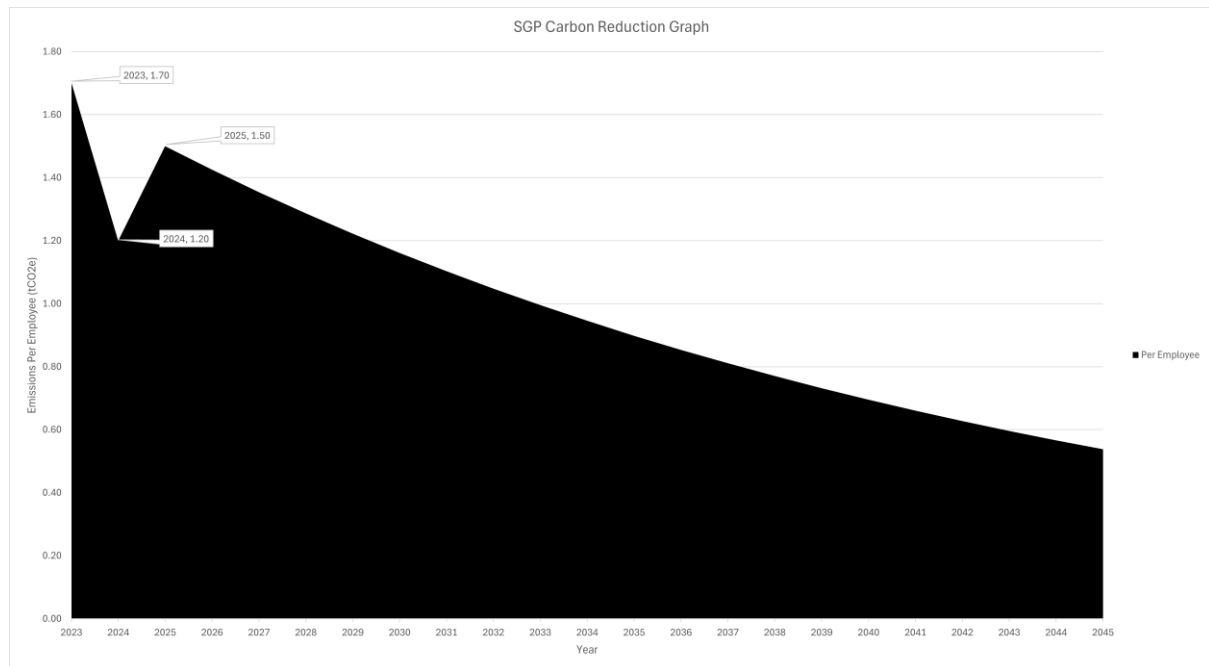
Emissions Reduction Targets

To continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

As part of commitment to reduced emissions with Planet Mark we have agreed to reduce our total emissions by 5% each year.

To show progress against these targets, when different scope 3 emissions have been measured each year, we are reporting the carbon reduction per employee for employee-based emissions (Scopes 1-3 excluding Purchased Goods & Services).
